

**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE  
THE SECONDARY SYSTEM SIX-YEAR PLAN (FY 27-32)**

**WHEREAS**, Virginia Code § 33.2-331 provides the opportunity for each county to work with the Virginia Department of Transportation in developing a Secondary System Six-Year Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 1, 2026, the Board held a work session and agreed to assist in the preparation of this Plan, in accordance with the Virginia Department of Transportation policies and procedures;

**WHEREAS**, on May 20, 2026, the Board held a public hearing on the proposed Plan (FY 27-32), after being duly advertised so that all residents of the County had the opportunity to participate in said hearing and to make comments and recommendations concerning the proposed Plan and Priority List; and

**WHEREAS**, local and regional representatives of the Virginia Department of Transportation recommend approval of the Secondary System Six Year Plan (FY27-32); and

**WHEREAS**, the Secondary System Six Year Plan (FY 27-32) is in the best interest of the County and of the residents of the County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Secondary System Six-Year Plan (FY 27-32) and authorizes the County Executive to sign the Secondary System Six-Year Plan (FY 27-32); and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the clerk of the Board shall forward a certified copy of this resolution to the District Administrator of the Virginia Department of Transportation.
