Secondary Six-Year Plan Background

- The Secondary Six-Year Plan is a VDOT document that
 - Applies to roads in the secondary system
 - Identifies the funding allocated for the next fiscal year and estimates the available funding for the next five fiscal years,
 - Telefee and District Grant Unpaved Funds
 - \$1,207,087 tentatively available in FY27 for Albemarle County projects (primarily for paving unpaved roads)
 - Lists the Albemarle County projects that will receive funding from these sources
 - Updated and adopted by the Board of Supervisors annually



Unpaved Road Improvement Program Updates

- Staff presented the draft URIP document at the April 1 work session. URIP is a new program that would do improvements to unpaved roads but not pave them
- Staff recommended Burch's Creek Road, Batesville Road, and Hammocks Gap Road for this year's URIP, there is not funding available for FY 27, but staff will work with VDOT to add these roads to FY 28
- Following BOS and VDOT feedback, staff is ready to implement the URIP starting next FY



FY 27-32 SSYP – Rural Rustic

- Roads that have provided documentation of support from two-thirds of the residential homeowners and received VDOT validation:
 1. Old Sand Road (Route 717)
 2. Gilbert Station Road (Route 640)
 3. Giannini Lane (Route 613)
 4. Murray Lane (Route 718)
 5. Blacks Lane (Route 638)
 6. Broken Sun Road (Route 748)
