What is chronic absenteeism?

A student is chronically absent if at any point in the year they have accumulated absences of 10% or more excluding religious observances and extended medical absences with doctor's orders. Days of suspension are included as accumulated absences.

A note on May Data:

May data is still only a tentative projection for the yearly chronic absenteeism rate. Adjustments to the overall rate, including any students who recovered days through flexible, in-person instruction have not been completed and are finalized over the summer.
