Due to cancellation of a spring course by DCJS, and conflict between the CCS Leadership Advance & Safety Summit dates with the DCJS July course; the CHS, CMS & LMA administrators still needing this DCJS course are scheduled for dates between August and October. The CCS Summer Safety Summit was held on July 28th at CATEC. Principals, AP's and other office staff received training from CCS division leaders, City Emergency Management and first responders covering:

- Nurse & School Medical Management Teams Protocols
- Incident Command & Exercising Crisis Plans
- Volunteer & Visitor Management
- CCS SRO Program - review of expectations, roles & responsibilities
- Safety Preparations for the New School Year & Pre-Week Training in Schools

Safety Summit topics will also be covered with the CSA team and SROs during **the CSA Safety Intensive** scheduled for the afternoon of August 6th in the CMS Media Center.

The CSA track for PL Palooza includes the Medical Management Team training, CPR/First Aid certification on-line and in-person training sessions, and a session to review RADAR concepts for continuous improvement, along with a choice session.

All Principals have been provided with the **Pre-Week School Safety PL** presentation materials which review school climate & culture expectations, CCS Standard Response Protocols (SRPs), drill requirements, and the Standard Reunification Method (SRM). This presentation for all staff is followed by a presentation to review ALICE concepts and a series of scripted ALICE lockdown drills. The final step in pre-week safety training is a Google Form that principals send to their building staff to certify that they have completed certain safety preparations and to submit any safety procedure related questions if they have outstanding concerns. The Pre-Week School Safety PL program compliments independent online learning modules related to safety that are assigned and communicated to all staff prior to the new school year.

Mr. Jordan continues to monitor the status of all CCS CSAs to ensure they obtain and maintain their DCJS certification as School Security Officers (SSOs), and Mandt certification for CSAs is managed in conjunction with the CCS Student Services team.
