

ORDINANCE ENACTING CHAPTER 6 - BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, ARTICLE F –
PRIVATE TOWING ADVISORY BOARD, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
CITY OF HARRISONBURG, VIRGINIA

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Harrisonburg, Virginia:

The following Article and Section be enacted as shown:

ARTICLE F. – PRIVATE TOWING ADVISORY BOARD

Sec. 3-6-51. Private towing advisory board established.

In accordance with Code of Virginia, § 46.2-1233, the city hereby establishes a towing advisory board consisting of two representatives from the police department; two representatives from licensed local towing and recovery operators; and one citizen representative. Said advisory board shall meet at least once per year at the call of the chairperson of the advisory board, who shall be elected annually from among the voting members of the advisory board by a majority vote. The towing advisory board shall act in an advisory capacity and make recommendations to the city council on issues related to rates to be charged by towing or recovery operators for the towing or moving of vehicles or other items within the city, the regulations that towing and recovery operators are to be governed by, and such other duties as may be assigned to it by the city council. Members shall be appointed by the city council to serve three-year terms.
