

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING
SECTION 7-2-19(b)(7) – CONSERVATION OF WATER DURING EMERGENCIES OR
DROUGHT, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
CITY OF HARRISONBURG, VIRGINIA

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Harrisonburg, Virginia:

The following Section be amended as shown:

Sec. 7-2-19(b)(7). Conservation of water during emergencies or drought.

- (7) Upon notification to the city council that a drought stage exists, the city council may pass a resolution declaring a drought stage. The city council may declare a drought stage in the absence of a declaration by the Commonwealth of Virginia; however, the city council must declare a drought emergency upon the declaration of a drought emergency by the Commonwealth of Virginia in the Shenandoah Drought Evaluation Region or by the ~~Roekingham County, Virginia Board of Supervisors~~ City in accordance with ~~Roekingham County~~ City's Drought Management Ordinance.
