**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE/DENY PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE 2040
LOUISA COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; CPA2026-01**

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the 2040 Louisa County Comprehensive Plan adopted September 2019 is to add an appendix to the Comprehensive Plan (2040 Plan) to include an Electric Transmission and Corridor Policy; and

WHEREAS, Louisa County recognizes the growing regional demand for electric transmission infrastructure to support economic development, energy reliability, and emerging high demand uses. At the same time, the County places a high priority on preserving its rural character, protecting agricultural and forestal lands, and minimizing impacts to existing communities; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this addendum is to address the siting and evaluation of electric transmission infrastructure. This policy establishes a clear, consistent framework to guide local decision-making and regional engagement while aligning with the County's long-term land use, growth management, and rural preservation goals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 18th day of May 2026, that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby approves/denies the proposed amendments to the 2040 Louisa County Comprehensive Plan, as attached.
