Re: Notification of Environmental, Civil Survey Activities

To Whom It May Concern,

Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (“TCO” or “Columbia”), a TC Energy Company, is reviewing the energy infrastructure needs in your area. Over the next few weeks, a TCO representative will be contacting Landowners to discuss environmental and civil survey activities on or around their Property. In some areas, we may be contacting Landowners even though TCO does not have an existing easement on their Property. The purpose of these surveys is to better understand the geographic landscape of this area and any special or distinct environmental features located within the vicinity. TCO commonly performs surveys like this when considering improvements to its proposed or existing pipeline infrastructure so that we can continue to move natural gas safely and responsibly.

Columbia is aware that certain properties in Louisa County may be located within the Green Springs National Historic Landmark District and/or listed on the National Register of Historic Places and recognizes the district’s important historical and cultural value. For your awareness, we will also be consulting with the Virginia Department of Historic Resources (VDHR) prior to performing archeological and architectural surveys on these properties. The surveys will provide essential information to support the consultation process with VDHR as well as other agencies and stakeholders.

What Landowners Can Expect

Survey activities will only take place during reasonable daylight hours beginning on or around the week of March 16, 2026. This timeframe may change as our workflow can be impeded by weather. TCO employees and contractors conducting surveys always carry proper identification and will present this identification if asked. Prior notification will be given to Landowners before surveyors will be in their area.
