**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING LLOYD RUNNETT FOR HIS YEARS OF SERVICE
TO LOUISA COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the Louisa County Board of Supervisors wishes to recognize and honor Mr. Lloyd Runnett for his dedicated service to Louisa County; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Runnett began his lifelong commitment to public service in 1972 as a volunteer with the Mineral Volunteer Fire Department, faithfully serving the citizens of Louisa County for decades through volunteer emergency response and public service; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Runnett served as Chief of the Mineral Volunteer Fire Department from 1993 through 1997, and again from 2022 through 2025, providing mentorship and unwavering dedication to generations of firefighters and emergency responders within the community; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Runnett graduated from Louisa County High School in 1979 and began his professional career with Dominion Energy, then known as Virginia Electric and Power Company (VEPCO), before pursuing a distinguished career in fire and emergency services; and

WHEREAS, in 1984, Mr. Runnett joined the Richmond Bureau of Fire, serving for three years before continuing his fire service career with the Henrico Division of Fire, where he faithfully served for approximately twenty-three years until his retirement, dedicating nearly three decades

of professional service to protecting the citizens of Central Virginia; and

WHEREAS, following retirement from professional fire service, Mr. Runnett answered another call to public service by accepting the role of Executive Director of the Louisa County Resource Council in 2015, where he continued serving the citizens of Louisa County with compassion, leadership, and a servant's heart, becoming a trusted and familiar presence within the community; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Runnett's compassion and warm personality endeared him to those he worked with, and he focused on making LCRC clients feel valued and important while demonstrating a willingness to listen and find solutions for those in need throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, under his leadership, the number of families served through the Community Cupboard nearly doubled to more than 1,800 families while new programs such as the Community Closet, Children's Feeding Program, Wheels for Work, and Dental Assistance Program were established to better serve those in need; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Runnett fostered partnerships and community collaboration with local churches, schools, civic organizations, and volunteers, while ensuring LCRC remained operational during local emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, following the 2011 Louisa earthquake, Mr. Runnett organized the Louisa Cares initiative in partnership with the Fluvanna-Louisa Housing Foundation, helping raise funds and coordinate support for vulnerable families impacted by the disaster and demonstrating exceptional leadership and compassion during one of the county's most difficult times; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Runnett also served as an influential supporter and leader within the Louisa Santa Council, dedicating countless hours to assisting low-income families during the Christmas season by helping provide gifts, necessities, and support to children and families in need throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, the Louisa County Board of Supervisors desires to express its sincere appreciation for Mr. Runnett's years of faithful service and his lasting impact on the citizens of Louisa County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 1st day of June, 2026, that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes and honors Mr. Lloyd Runnett for his outstanding leadership, dedicated public service, and lasting contributions to the citizens of Louisa County, and extends its gratitude and best wishes for the future.
