

LOUISA COUNTY SYNTHETIC TURF FIELDS



CLOSED WHEN GATES ARE LOCKED. DO NOT USE WITHOUT SUPERVISION.

The rules below are designed to protect the fields. Failure to comply with these rules may result in removal from the facility and/or cancellation of current and future reservations. Staff may exercise discretion for items without written approval that are not listed. Do not use the fields if dangerous conditions exist.

EQUIPMENT

- Approved equipment only.
- Molded or rubber cleats and athletic shoes only (no metal spikes).
- Equipment on the field, including goals and scoreboards, may not be moved by users.
- Adhere to load limits, including no more than 35PSI for transient or dynamic loads.
- All outside equipment must be approved by Parks and Recreation staff before use.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- No sharp objects, stakes, or corner flags.
- No bicycles, skateboards, roller skates, strollers, or similar devices.
- No food, gum, seeds, or shelled nuts.
- Water only; no sports drinks.
- No tobacco products.
- No glass containers.
- No fireworks, smoke machines, portable heaters, or open flames.
- No suntan lotions, oils, or creams (apply sunscreen before entering the field).
- No chairs, tables, coolers, or other items directly on the turf.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- No golfing or chipping.
- No throwing events such as hammer, shot put, discus, or javelin.
- No digging, pulling, or disturbing turf fibers or infill.
- No digging with feet, hands, or other objects.
- No pets allowed. Service animals are permitted.
- No marking the turf with unauthorized paint or chalk.
